



## **PISA & LUCCA**



- Ⓢ *Departure from the Hotel at about 08:00 in the morning*

*"Pisa: The city and its miracles"*

*The city tour includes, in addition to the religious center with the Leaning Tower, the Dome and the Baptistry, also a short walk through Via Santa Maria, to the Romanesque church dedicated to St. Sixtus and the Renaissance Piazza dei Cavalieri by Giorgio Vasari, which is now the seat of the Normal School, and from there through the typical market in Piazza delle Vettovaglie up to the Arno river. You will see the house of Vincenzo Galilei, father of Galileo and Dante Square, the center of the city's university district.*

- Ⓢ *At 1:30 pm departure for Lucca – Arrival at about 2:00 pm*
- Ⓢ *Walking tour into the historical centre with the guide:*

*Surrounded by intact Renaissance walls, the city boasts a historical center where medieval buildings follow one another in the main streets. Sights: The church of San Michele in Foro, the Cathedral of San Martino, the Church of St. Michael in the Pisan - Romanesque style and the church of San Frediano. Lucca still keeps intact its medieval town planning and building structure made up of narrow and charming streets; one of the most important monuments of the city is undoubtedly the Guinigi Tower, its main feature is the presence of a huge oak on top of it.*

*The Market Square was built in the ancient structure of the Roman Amphitheatre. Other places worth visiting are Palazzo Mansi and Guinigi the museum, the birthplace of Giacomo Puccini, Palazzo Pfanner and the Botanical Garden.*
